

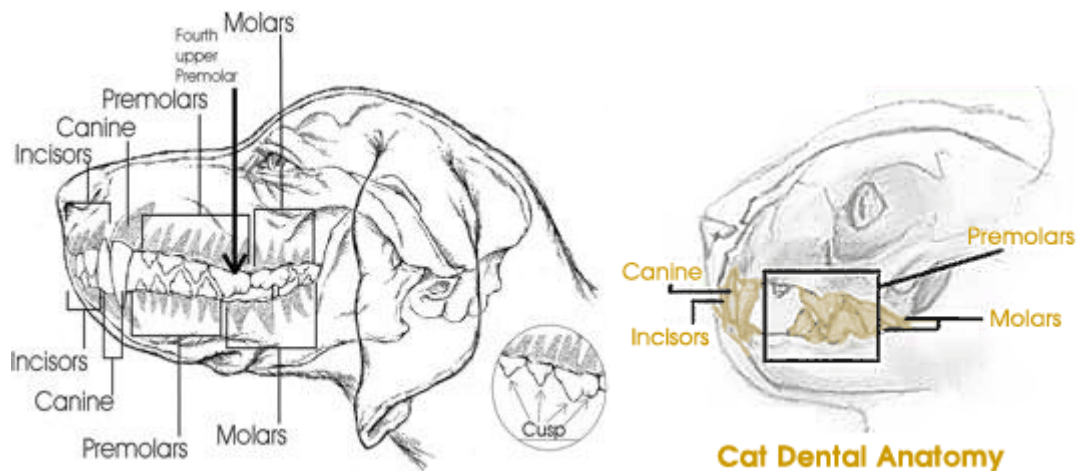

Post-Operative Instructions for Dentals

- Your pet has been under general anesthesia and has had his/ her teeth thoroughly scaled and polished. Any damaged and/or infected teeth have been removed.
- Your pet will probably be very sleepy tonight. Keep your pet inside in a small, warm and quiet area where he/she can rest and recover from the anesthesia.
- Your pet was given an antibiotic shot. If your pet goes home with any medication, please give it exactly as directed.
- Your pet may be fed a light meal this evening, if interested. It is recommended that if your pet regularly eats dry food, that it is first soaked in water. Occasionally, after being under anesthesia, your pet may lose his/ her appetite and/ or be sick. If this continues for more than 24 hours, or you are concerned, please call us at the number listed above.
- Your pet may dribble blood stained saliva for a couple days after the surgery; this is not unusual, but if it appears excessive, please contact us at the above number for advice.



Call Us if You Note Any of the Following

- Lethargy or depression lasting for more than 48 hours after the dental.
- Vomiting and/ or diarrhea.
- Difficulty urinating.
- Pale gums.
- Labored breathing,
